As we walk into a new year, I find myself reflecting deeply on God's grace and mercy that carried us through 2025. Scripture reminds us, "The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases; his mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning" (Lamentations 3:22–23 ESV).

As women, many of us carried silent battles—holding families together, praying through tears no one saw, showing strength when we felt weak, and trusting God even when we didn't fully understand His plan. This past year may have brought moments of sickness, uncertainty, heartbreak, and change. Some of us lost people we loved, some carried burdens we didn't speak out loud, and others walked through seasons of transition. Yet even in those moments, God reminded us that "The LORD is near to the brokenhearted and saves the crushed in spirit" (Psalm 34:18 ESV).

As women of faith, we've learned that God's grace is not just something we hear about; it's something we live through daily. His peace has guarded our hearts (Philippians 4:6–7), His faithfulness has steadied us, and His purpose still stands—because "for those who love God all things work together for good" (Romans 8:28 ESV).

So as we step into this new year, we do so with gratitude for what God has already carried us through and confidence in what He is yet to do. We move forward anchored in His promises, strengthened by His presence, and secure in His love—knowing He is faithful and He will never leave us (Hebrews 13:5).





If there were cycles that kept you stuck...


If there were moments you look back on with regret or frustration...
